



Multi-genre artist **Isadar** focuses exclusively on solo piano with his new 2012 release. This marks his 15th album, and his 7th solo piano release to date. The intent of this album is to introduce his vast and eclectic collection of solo piano music to a broader audience utilizing a fresh new package and presentation. This release is also a launching pad to set-up a new Christmas piano album for a November release as well as a brand new solo piano record next year. This album is 65 minutes in length. Includes the technical piece, "Throwing The Dice."

Reconstructed is a revisiting and re-working of compositions that it's producer Will Ackerman felt were his strongest works released over the past 20 years. These new versions are subtly (but in some cases radically) changed, unfolding with a more intimate sound and environment that is the signature of Ackerman's award-winning productions.
